I certify that I have read and understood the below statements and all the questions set forth in this Form, and I also certify that the answers I have furnished on this Form are true and correct to the best of my knowledge and belief. I understand and agree that:

- Any false or misleading statement in my Application may result in the permanent refusal of a permit or denial of entry into the CNMI.
- Possession of a VEP does not automatically entitle me to enter the CNMI if at a port-of-entry I am found to be inadmissible under the law.
- In no case shall the issuance of a VEP give rise to a claim or right or entitlement to citizenship or permanent residency, or benefit or privilege, where requirements for such benefit or privilege have not been met.
- **The issuance of a VEP does not allow me to work or seek work in the CNMI, or entitle me to apply for a business license. If caught working in the CNMI, I will be penalized civilly or criminally, possibly including fines, jail, deportation, and permanent banishment from the CNMI.**

The Division of Immigration may require an individual or business sponsor to provide supporting proof of financial ability. A Self-Sponsor must provide a Declaration of Financial Ability and supporting proof of financial ability. Model Affidavits of Sponsorship and Support and Declarations of Financial Ability, as well as a list of acceptable proof of financial ability, are available at [www.cnmiago.gov.mp](http://www.cnmiago.gov.mp), or may be sent by Fax upon request.

\*\*An indication of purpose for Tourism enables applicant to later apply with the Division of Immigration for a Long-Term Tourist Entry Permit; an indication of purpose for Business enables applicant to later apply with the Division of Immigration for a Regular-Term Business Entry Permit.
